Helicopter into the Wilderness

Your helicopter collects you from Remarkables Lodge to fly you across Lake Wakatipu with views to Queenstown and the Dart River, landing at the Cascade Hut high in the 65,000 acre/100 sq mile Walter Peak high country station. Here you will spend the next two days, sharing it with only the wildlife.

You'll be met by your qualified high country guide; ex army special forces, first aid trained and Qualmark endorsed – and he's even a bit of an expert on the barbecue.

Abandon your pack at the hut and walk to one of the local lakes or rivers, looking out for wild deer or spotting rainbow trout – perhaps try your hand at fly fishing. Return to the hut for a well earned afternoon tea.



Horse Riding Option

Alternatively take the S/S Earnslaw across the lake (or helicopter to the horse barn) and meet your guide ready to horse ride to the hut . The ride into the Cascade Hut will take most of the day, but there will be plenty of opportunity to enjoy the scenery and a relaxing picnic lunch while the horses rest. To take this option you need to have moderate riding experience (able to trot for example).

At the Cascade Hut

Enjoy a hot shower, stroll down to the creek that runs close to the hut (and retrieve a strategically placed bottle of chilling wine), listen to the sounds of silence in the wilderness or get your guide to regale you with tales of mustering on remote stations. Snuggle up in front of the wood burner, and savour the aromas of dinner, pre-prepared by the Remarkables Lodge chef, with the finishing touches applied by your cook.

The Cascade Hut has gas powered hot water showers, flushing toilets, wood burner fire and a gas range for cooking. Accommodation is in a bunk room with linen and towels provided by the lodge. Dinner, breakfast and lunches are prepared at the Lodge and flown to Cascade Hut.

The hut can sleep 8 people and is for single party use only. The hut is perfect for a romantic honeymoon couple, an incentive group, a family or a group of friends.

There is an option to spend a second night in the hut.



Return to the Lodge

Next day walk (or horse ride) out along the Cascade Creek and over the Afton Saddle through pristine native bush with stunning views across to the Mount Earnslaw glacier and the islands on Lake Wakatipu (17km /3-4 hour walk to the Honeymoon Hut).

Honeymoon hut, built in the 1900's as a stockman's shelter and with it's history still engraved on the walls, is a delightful location for a final cup of tea before your transfer back to the Lodge. Either your helicopter collects you from the Honeymoon Hut for the return flight or you take a 4WD vehicle to catch the S/S Earnslaw to Queenstown and back to the Lodge, where a deep claw-footed bath awaits, or soak your tired muscles in the hydrotherapy spa before joining the other guests for dinner, eager to hear about your unique foray into the wilderness.



Inclusions:

- Three nights accommodation – 1st and 3rd nights at the lodge, 2nd night at the Cascade Hut.

- Breakfast, lunch and dinner
- Private guide and cook/housekeeper for the hut

Options:

- Horse riding
- Fly fishing
- Extra nights on the Station with additional hikes

Cost:
