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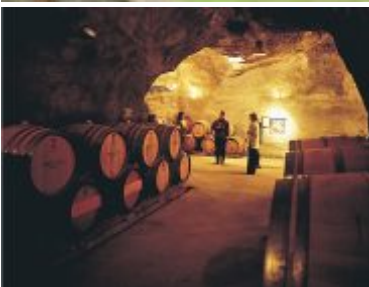

Arrive at the lodge to enjoy dinner prepared by the lodge's resident chef. Before dinner sample our *Chard Farm Sauvignon Blanc* and with dinner a bottle of *Saddleback Pinot Noir* from award winning Peregrine winery.

Next morning your private wine guide will collect you from the lodge to begin your day of wine exploration visiting a selection of local wineries featured on our wine list. The journey will take you through the stunning Kawarau Gorge to Cromwell and Bannockburn and on to lunch at Carrick winery.

If you would like to develop your tasting skills, spending time in an aroma room and visiting a wine cave are interesting interludes. A cheese platter of local cheeses aids the tasting process during the afternoon.

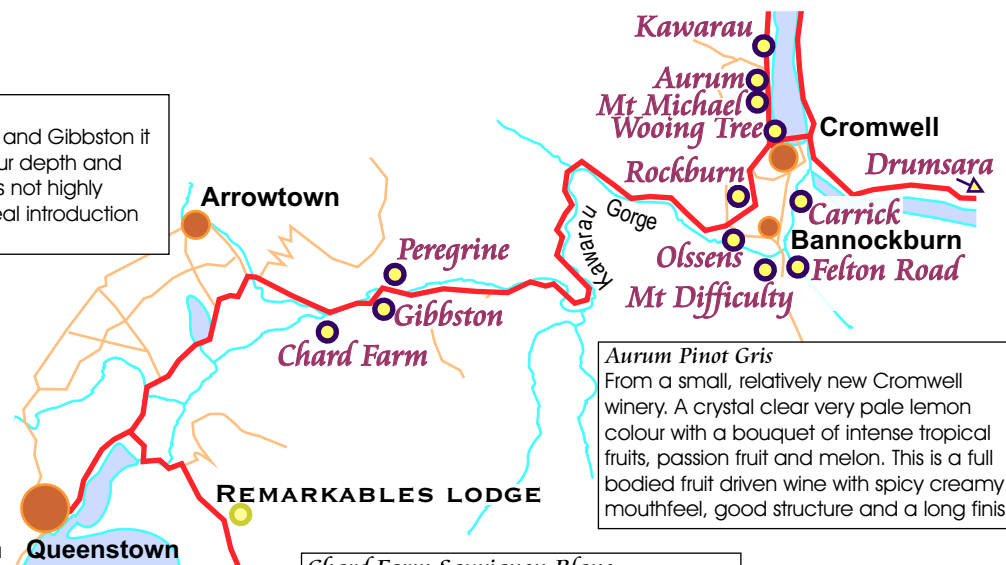
Return to the lodge to relax and sample *Aurum's Pinot Gris*, then make your choice from our wine list of any of our South Island wines to enjoy with dinner.

Peregrine Saddleback Pinot Noir

Grown at Lowburn, in the Cromwell basin, and Gibbston it has a deep colour and good body, flavour depth and roundness. Smooth and fruit crammed, it's not highly complex but fresh and vibrant and an ideal introduction to the regions Pinot Noir.

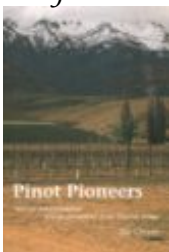


Aurum Pinot Gris

From a small, relatively new Cromwell winery. A crystal clear very pale lemon colour with a bouquet of intense tropical fruits, passion fruit and melon. This is a full bodied fruit driven wine with spicy creamy mouthfeel, good structure and a long finish.

Pinot Pioneers by Ric Oram

A highly readable account of how Central Otago came to gain credibility as a wine producer – and all because a few determined people began planting grapes for wine there in the late 1970s. Today's Otago pinot noir industry is a testament to their ingenuity, their improvisation, their determination and perseverance and just sheer hard work.



Chard Farm Sauvignon Blanc

The strong Bell Pepper notes of Central Otago are tamed by some lovely ripe Marlborough fruit. More refreshing than a cold shower. A racy and zingy blend of Sauvignon fruit.
